New Members of the HFHMM Board of Directors

Replacements are Made as Two Board Members Finish Their Term

SILVER SPRING, MD (June 12, 2017) — This July, Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland's Board of Directors will experience some changes. Two valued members of the board, Jeff Hollingsworth and Ericc Powell, will finish their terms of service, and their seats will be replaced by Tom Albert and Robyn Motley.

Jeff Hollingsworth served as the HFHMM Board of Directors Chairman and is a longtime supporter of our affiliate. He was originally nominated to our Board of Directors in 1995, served as treasurer and chairman, and then after a short sabbatical returned to the board in 2008. Hollingsworth also served as a member of the nominating and finance committees. Teaching at the University of Maryland since 1994, he was a Professor and Associate Chair at the University of Maryland in the Computer Science Department, UMIACS, and the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department. He recently started a new position as the Interim Chief Information Officer (CIO) in UMD's Division of Information Technology.

Ericc Powell has dedicated numerous years volunteering with Habitat for Humanity, originally with the Providence, RI, affiliate. Ericc also dedicates his time to AmeriCorps*VISTA, first serving with the Rhode Island Campus Compact at Roger Williams University, then later as the Illinois Campus Compact AmeriCorps*VISTA Leader and Program Coordinator. He currently works at the Corporation for National and Community Service in Washington, D.C., as an AmeriCorps*VISTA Training Coordinator. Ericc is known for his contagious smile and love of people.

Tom Albert comes to HFHMM with years of experience in directing residential and commercial building developments. He currently co-leads the early stages of a mixed-use development in partnership with the Bozzuto Group. Tom is involved in professional associations such as the Urban Land Institute and the District of Columbia Building Industry Association, and was the director of Building Impact from 2005-2011. He received his BS in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Massachusetts, and his MBA from Babson College.

Robyn Motley is the Vice President and General Manager of AARP Media Properties.
