Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland currently tithes to Habitat for Humanity Nepal. It is our belief that in the wake of the earthquakes in Nepal we need to work together more than ever to provide pathways to permanence for the families affected. With a multiyear tithe commitment, we hope to help stabilize housing in disaster affected areas and provide safe and decent shelters for families in need. HFHMM sent its first global village team to Nepal in October of 2016 to help rebuild a community destroyed by the earthquakes.

How Habitat for Humanity Works

Through volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds, repairs and rehabilitates decent houses alongside our Habitat homebuyers.

Habitat is not a giveaway program

In addition to paying monthly mortgage payments, homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor - what we call “sweat equity” – into building their Habitat house and the houses of others. Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no profit and are financed with affordable loans.

How Habitat Partner Families are Selected

Habitat partner families are chosen based on their need, their willingness to become partners in the program and their ability to repay the loan.

We follow a nondiscriminatory policy of family selection. We are an Equal Housing Opportunity Lender.
