



Through volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds, repairs and rehabilitates decent houses alongside our Habitat homebuyers.

Habitat is not a Giveaway Program

In addition to paying monthly mortgage payments, homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor - what we call "sweat equity" – into building their Habitat house and the houses of others. Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no profit and are financed with affordable loans.

How Habitat Partner Families are Selected

Habitat partner families are chosen based on their need, their willingness to become partners in the program and their ability to repay the loan. We follow a nondiscriminatory policy of family selection. We are an Equal Housing Opportunity Lender.


