

## HFHMM Safety Protocol for Golfers (Covid-19 response)

- The John Lippincott Memorial Tournament Golf Committee is committed for each participant to have a safe, fun and productive golf outing at all times. Here are the anticipated guidelines for the tournament but may be updated closer to the event.
- It is critical that golfers NOT PARTICIPATE while they are experiencing illness symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, or loss of taste or smell or if they have had close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19 within the past 2 weeks. Golfers who appear to have symptoms upon arrival or who have become sick during the day will immediately be separated from others and sent home.
- All attendees are advised to practice physical distancing of at least six feet, where possible. Avoid handshakes and other forms of physical contact greetings. We recommend that you do not congregate on the golf course. Wash your hands frequently.
- All golfers are responsible for bringing their own masks and gloves, if applicable. Hand sanitizer will be provided in each cart for players.
- The course will provide 2 carts per foursome. We will try and honor any single rider requests but requests are not guaranteed. If a player is uncomfortable riding with someone else, they should prepare to walk. Walkers are welcome to put their bags on the cart of a playing partner and alternate walking alongside during play.
- The clubhouse is limited to restrooms and the golf shop. All attendees will need to wear a mask inside the clubhouse.
- Lunch will be provided as a box lunch and dinner will be provided in a take-out container.
