THE WASHINGTON COMMANDERS AND BANK OF AMERICA TEAM UP WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY METRO MD TO SUPPORT AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Volunteers from the Washington Commanders and Bank of America support affordable housing, help out on a Habitat for Humanity Build site and Montgomery County Public Schools.

Silver Spring, MD (April 17, 2024) — The Washington Commanders and Bank of America have joined forces with Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland and will be participating in a volunteer build day to support affordable housing and community projects in the local area. On Wednesday, April 17th, volunteers from the Washington Commanders and Bank of America will roll up their sleeves and don their hard hats as they join Habitat for Humanity to help with volunteer projects such as Allium Place, a new affordable housing community, and neighborhood engagement projects at Montgomery County Public Schools. This collaboration marks a significant milestone in the Commanders' and Bank of America's ongoing commitments to making a positive impact in the local community.

Allium Place, one of the projects that the volunteers will work on, is an innovative development nestled near the intersection of Randolph and Veirs Mill Road that unites Montgomery County, AHC, Inc., and Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland to transform 6.2 acres of formerly county-owned land into a vibrant, desirable, and transit-oriented mixed-income affordable housing community. Habitat Metro Maryland is building 27 homeownership units as part of the larger Allium Place Community which co-locates 3 single family detached homes and 24 owner-occupied condos on a larger parcel with 160+ rental residences.

The Washington Commanders' and Bank of America's involvement with Habitat for Humanity underscores their dedication to giving back to the community that has long supported them. By volunteering their time and energy, the team hopes to inspire others to join them in making a difference in the lives of underserved communities in Montgomery County.
