Volunteer Committee: Development & Fundraising

- Audit and report on all pledges

Members: Members shall include the Director of Development, Development Staff, two to three members of the Board of Directors and enthusiastic volunteers.

Meetings: Bi-Monthly Meetings held on the 3rd Tuesday of the Month from 7:00pm to 8:30pm.
