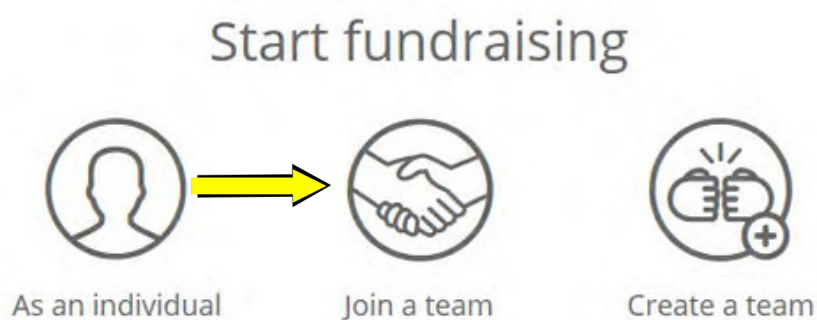
My Fundraising Toolbox

How To Get Started



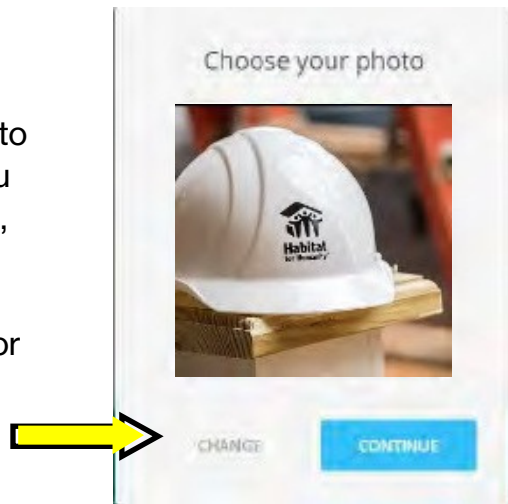
1. Go to <https://give.classy.org/HFHMMWomenBuild2026>
2. Once you are on the Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland Women Build 2026 fundraising page you will see two large buttons: “Become a Fundraiser” and “Donate Now”. Choose “Become a Fundraiser” so you can start raising funds.
3. The next screen will say “Start Fundraising”, with two options: “Join a team” and “Create a team”. Select “Join a team”.



4. The next screen will say “Join a team”. Click your team's name or you can search by team name.
5. Create a Classy account, or log in if you have participated in the past.

6. Complete your profile.
7. Choose your photo and click "Continue".

This is the default photo for all individuals. If you would like to change it, click "Change", and upload a photo from either your computer or Facebook profile.



8. Create your page.

A short URL can make it easier for people to find your team page and donate. But, it is not necessary to fundraise successfully.



Your personal fundraising goal is set at a minimum of \$400.



Incentives start at \$800 and prizes are awarded at each level.

We encourage you to raise more! The more you raise helps us build more homes.

Fundraising Tips

How do I raise \$400 in one week?

- Make a donation to yourself – \$50
- Ask 6 family members for \$25 each – \$150
- Ask 5 neighbors for \$10 each – \$50
- Ask 10 friends for \$15 each – \$150

TOTAL: \$400



How do I raise \$800? That's easy!

- Make a donation to yourself – \$75
- Ask 5 family members for \$25 each – \$125
- Ask 10 co-workers for \$10 each - \$100
- Ask 10 neighbors for \$10 each – \$100
- Share your Classy fundraising page on social media – \$200
- Ask 10 friends for \$20 each-\$200

TOTAL: \$800

I want a challenge! How can I raise \$1,600 in a week?

- Make a donation to yourself – \$100
- Ask 8 family members for \$25 each – \$200
- Ask 10 co-workers for \$10 each - \$100
- Ask 10 neighbors for \$15 each – \$150
- Ask 20 friends for \$20 each – \$400
- Share your Classy fundraising page on social media – \$300
- Use our memory jogger to think of all the people you can ask a donation from. If you feel comfortable, you can ask for a bigger donation – \$150
- Clean out your garage for a yard sale – \$100
- Have two bake sales – \$100

TOTAL: \$1,600

Don't forget to ask your company about matching gifts and watch your donations double!

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need construction experience or expertise?

Absolutely not. No construction experience required. We will provide you with all the safety gear, tools, and know-how you will need. Our talented volunteer Crew Leaders will show you the ropes.

Can I join more than one team?

You can only associate your personal fundraising page with one team.

What happens when someone donates directly to a team's page?

The money donated directly to a team page is reflected in the team page total. It is NOT reflected in any of the individual team members' totals. If you want a donation to show up in your personal total AND the team total, you should have the donor contribute through your personal page.

If I donate to an individual or team fundraising page, who will have access to my information?

When you make a donation through an individual or team fundraising page, HFHMM will have access to your contact information. If you contribute through a personal fundraising page, then the person that created that page will have access to a report with your contact information. If you contribute through a personal fundraising page associated with a team or if you contribute directly to a team fundraising page, then the person that created the team page will also have access to a report with your contact information.

What if I don't want to fundraise and just want to donate the \$400 so that I can participate in Women Build?

No problem! You still need to "become a fundraiser" and make the donation to your page.

Can youth volunteer at the build site?

Children and youth of all ages can assist with fundraising efforts, however, participants on the build site must be 18 years or older. However, we do have other volunteer opportunities for our younger supporters. Contact us for more information.

What if someone can only stay half the day?

We strongly encourage participants to stay the entire day (8:30 am – 3:00 pm) as they will feel a greater sense of accomplishment and take part in all the perks the day has to offer. In the event of an emergency, we do understand and ask that you contact the Habitat staff as soon as possible.

How does Habitat empower women?

We at Habitat have the ability to provide opportunities for hands-on learning, and given these tools, women can succeed in changing their communities. Nationally, more than 60% of Habitat for Humanity's projects are homes to female head of households. Due to skills they learn while building their Habitat home, these women are better equipped to maintain their homes, and consequently, more confident in their ability to cope with day-to-day situations.

WHAT IF MY SUPPORTERS WANT TO MAKE THEIR DONATION IN THE FORM OF CASH OR A CHECK?

While the online fundraising tool is very handy, cash and checks are welcome, too! Just provide the donation form (on the next page of this packet) to your donors. Donations should be sent to Habitat for Humanity by June 30, 2026. All checks should be made out to Metro Maryland Habitat for Humanity, with “Women Build (or WB)” and the participant’s name written in the memo line. When you send funds given to you to Habitat, please include a copy of this donation form because we want to be sure to credit you for the gifts! Your cash/checks will be credited to your web page as “offline” donations.
